IMPORTANT SUMMER CAMP INFORMATION

For each day of camp, participants are required to bring the following items: Water, hat, sunscreen, lunch, snacks, towel, bathing suit, a craft safe shirt. When at Victoria Park Thursdays, outdoor appropriate footwear & attire is required. Campers may be sent with cellular devices to contact their parents/guardians. However phones must not be used for entertainment throughout the day. Please note that campers are welcome to bring their own toys/books/games to camp, however the RECC is not responsible for any lost or damaged items.

CANCELLATION / REFUND POLICY:

48 hours notice by email/phone prior to the start date of the weekly camp date. Please email our Welcome Desk welcomedesk@therecc.ca to communicate cancellation. Prorated refunds not available for cancellations of single days of camp without a medical note. Refund cheques take 2-4 weeks to process or can be credited to your account.

REGISTRATION PROCEDURES: **Please have the participants health card number ready*

PUBLIC - in-person or online - Wed May 28 at 12 PM

Children must be 6-11 years old to participate in RECC day camps

After registration and payment has been completed. Required documents include:

1. One Online Camper Information Form for each camper (this includes our Refund Policy Agreement).
2. One Online Liability Waiver (with parent/guardian signature) on Smart Waiver
3. Health Card Number

Each participant must have all documents completed as soon as possible after registration.

PICK-UP AND DROP-OFF PROCEDURE:

DROP-OFF begins at 8:15am - 8:30am **PICK-UP** begins at 4:30pm - 4:45pm

Locations are listed in each week of camp. Any changes due to unforeseen circumstance or inclement weather will be communicated in advance, or as soon as possible with the communication method(s) provided on the registration form.

Upon drop-off, our camp staff will ensure all registration forms are completed before permitting you to sign your child(ren) in. **Camp staff will not permit your child to be signed-out by anyone who is not indicated on the "Pick-Up Information" section on the registration form.** If you require a late drop-off or early pick-up, email Abigail at youthprograms@ratheastlinkcc.ca. Otherwise, drop off and pick up times remain the same at each location listed below.

COUGAR DOME DAYS (WEDNESDAYS): **NO RECC lunch available*
